♥*Maternal Reasons:*

toxemia  
diabetes  
advanced age  
prolonged labor  
preterm delivery  
multiple gestation  
young primigravida  
substance exposure  
any serious condition

♥*Infant Indications:*

SGA or LGA  
dysmorphisms  
low Apgar scores  
abnormal ultrasound  
breech presentation  
abnormal neurological exam  
suspected genetic condition  
jittery – or exaggerated startle  
feeding problems – or tongue thrust  
floppy – or lack of strong flexor tone  
arching – or increased extensor tone

♥*Physician or Parent Concerns*
